After PhD:

1. 2 months after my PhD, I developed the PhD thesis into a software prototype, at a hackathon, where the project won first place in Civic Tech
2. I then continued with a 10-month postdoc at West University of Timisoara, where I scaled the methodology across 28 European countries, including the EU institutions, analyzing more than 10 million public procurement contracts
3. 3 years from my PhD, I implemented the methodology of analyzing inter-organizational networks in anti-competitive behavior in the Big Data platform of the Competition Council in Romania
